

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing, Home and Community)

In this course, you will learn how to provide support and direct care for clients in residential aged care, home or community settings. You'll gain an insight into the aged care and home and community care sector and undertake a supervised work placement where you get to put your skills into practice.

EARLY CHILDHOOD

CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care

Become a qualified assistant in the early childhood field. It is now mandatory for all workers in the field of Early Childhood Education and Care to have the Certificate III as a minimum qualification. On successful completion of this Certificate students have the option to enrol in the Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care, also offered by Living & Learning Nillumbik.

No previous experience or qualifications are required.

CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care

This qualification course is suitable for those wanting to take on higher levels of responsibility and leadership in an early childhood service.
